Summary

SB501 mandates the Secretary of Health and Human Services to create a strategy for public health readiness against AI threats.

Business Impact

If you operate in healthcare and use AI, you must prepare for potential AI-related health threats by the strategy's implementation date or face regulatory scrutiny.

Key Provisions

- Requires the Secretary of Health and Human Services to develop a public health strategy for AI threats.
- Focuses on enhancing public health preparedness and response mechanisms.
