Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services should halt the pilot program and should not jeopardize seniors' access to critical health care by utilizing artificial intelligence to determine Medicare coverage.

Introduced

Risk: Medium

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Sep 10, 2025): Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

Summary

This bill expresses the House's sense that CMS should stop using AI to determine Medicare coverage to protect seniors' access to healthcare.

Business Impact

If you operate in healthcare and use AI for Medicare coverage decisions, you must halt such practices immediately to avoid jeopardizing access for seniors.

Key Provisions

- Urges CMS to halt the pilot program using AI for Medicare coverage decisions.
- Emphasizes the need to protect seniors' access to healthcare.
- Expresses the House's sense regarding the implications of AI in healthcare.
