## Summary

This bill mandates state units in New York to purchase algorithmic decision systems that comply with specified responsible AI standards, including data privacy and security, and requires the commissioner of taxation and finance to adopt regulations.

## Business Impact

If you operate in New York and use algorithmic decision systems, you must ensure compliance with responsible AI standards by [date] or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- State units must purchase algorithmic decision systems adhering to specified responsible AI standards, including data privacy and security.
- The commissioner of taxation and finance is required to adopt certain regulations.
- The definition of unlawful discriminatory practice is altered to include acts performed through algorithmic decision systems.
