## Business Impact

If you operate a social media platform in New York, you must provide users their social graph upon request by January 1, 2025, or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Social media companies must provide users with their social graph upon request.
- Interoperability requirements for covered users' data are specified.
- The Attorney General can enforce compliance and establish regulations.
