A bill to require the Secretary of Defense to carry out a pilot program on using artificial intelligence-enabled software to optimize the workflow and operations of depots, shipyards, and other manufacturing facilities run by the Department of Defense, and for other purposes.

Summary

This bill mandates a pilot program for AI software to enhance workflow in DoD manufacturing facilities.

Business Impact

If you operate a manufacturing facility for the Department of Defense, you must participate in the AI pilot program or risk losing funding.

Key Provisions

- Mandates a pilot program for AI software in DoD facilities
- Focuses on optimizing workflow and operations
- Applies to depots, shipyards, and other manufacturing sites
