## Business Impact

If you operate a social media service in SC, you must provide data in a specified format or face civil penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Social media services must provide personal data upon request in a specified format.
- Social media companies are required to implement data interoperability interfaces, allowing seamless data exchange.
- The Act establishes requirements for data sharing between social media services.
- Civil penalties are provided for violations of this chapter, with specifics detailed in the full bill text.

- Provide consumers with access to their personal data upon request. | Who: Social media companies. | Penalty: Up to \$2,500 for each violation.
- Implement interoperability interfaces for data sharing. | Who: Social media companies. | Penalty: Up to \$2,500 for each violation.
