## Online Privacy Act of 2026

Introduced

Risk: High

Comprehensive

Effective: Jan 01, 2026 | Last Action (Mar 19, 2026): Referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, and in addition to the Committees on the Judiciary, and Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

## Summary

The Online Privacy Act of 2026 establishes the Digital Privacy Agency to oversee privacy standards and compliance.

## Business Impact

If you operate online services, you must comply with enhanced privacy regulations by 2026 or face significant penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Establishes the Digital Privacy Agency with enforcement powers.
- Imposes specific privacy and security standards on entities handling personal data.
