PROCUREMENT-LOCAL GOV AI

Summary

This bill establishes a 6-month pilot program to test AI applications in local government procurement across municipalities with populations under 200,000, selected by the contractor, supervised by the Department.

Business Impact

If you operate a local government in Illinois, you must consider AI tools for procurement modernization by the pilot program's start date or risk falling behind in efficiency.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a 6-month AI procurement modernization pilot program limited to municipalities with populations under 200,000.
- Allows a sole source contract for the pilot.
- Contractor selects municipalities for diverse testing environments.

Compliance Checklist

- Conduct a comprehensive procurement modernization study | Who: Amp AI, under the supervision of the Department
- Publish monthly progress dashboards | Who: Amp AI
