Summary

This bill relates to the use of AI by insurers in utilization reviews and establishes notice requirements for adverse determinations.

Business Impact

If you are an insurer using AI for utilization reviews, you must notify insureds and health care providers about AI usage by policy renewal or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- The bill addresses the use of AI in utilization reviews.
- The specific penalties for non-compliance cannot be confirmed without the full bill text.
- The bill text does not confirm exemptions for AI usage without notice.

Compliance Checklist

- Provide written notice about AI usage in utilization reviews | Who: Insurers | Penalty: Fines up to \$10,000 for willful violations
- Submit AI algorithms and training data to the superintendent | Who: Insurers | Penalty: License suspension or revocation
