Summary

The bill proposes a pilot program in Delaware to implement AI and XR technologies in schools.

Business Impact

If you operate a school in Delaware, you must participate in the AI and XR pilot program by selecting your school within 180 days or miss funding opportunities.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Artificial Intelligence and Extended Reality in Schools Pilot Program.

Compliance Checklist

- Select 12 schools to participate in the program | Who: Delaware Department of Education | Penalty: Potential loss of funding opportunities
- Provide necessary data to assess program effectiveness | Who: Participating schools | Penalty: Non-compliance may affect future participation
