## Summary

This bill prohibits the New York Department of Corrections from using AI in parole evaluations and transitional accountability plans.

## Business Impact

If you operate within New York's correctional system, you must cease using AI for parole evaluations immediately to avoid legal repercussions.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits the use of AI in evaluating rehabilitation risk and needs.
- Bans AI in determining parole eligibility and supervision levels.
- Restricts AI use in developing transitional accountability plans.
