Summary

The AI Image Disclosure Act suggests a requirement for disclosure of AI-generated content in New Jersey, but specifics are not confirmed without the bill text.

Business Impact

If you create or distribute AI-generated content in New Jersey, you must include specific disclosures by February 1, 2027, or face \$5,000 fines per violation.

Key Provisions

- Implied requirement for disclosure of AI-generated content.
- Specifics are not confirmed without the bill text.

Compliance Checklist

- Include manifest and latent disclosures in AI-generated content | Who: Covered providers | Penalty: \$5,000 per violation
- Ensure licensing agreements maintain latent disclosure capabilities | Who: Covered providers and licensees | Penalty: \$5,000 per violation
