Requires third party verification of compliance with transparency and safety requirements for developers of artificial intelligence models; requires publication of such compliance reports.

## Summary

This bill mandates third-party verification of compliance with AI safety and transparency requirements, including publishing findings, though the frequency is unspecified.

## Business Impact

If you are a large frontier AI developer in New York, you must engage a third-party verifier annually by 2029 or face penalties up to \$3 million.

## Key Provisions

- Requires third-party verification for AI developers.
- Developers must grant verifiers access to relevant materials.

## Compliance Checklist

- Engage a third-party verifier to assess compliance with AI framework | Who: Large frontier AI developers | Penalty: Up to \$3 million for non-compliance
- Publish a summary of the verifier's report on the company website | Who: Large frontier AI developers | Penalty: Civil penalties may apply
