Requires policing agencies to conduct an inventory of, and develop a publicly-available policy for, any artificial intelligence used to aid criminal investigations.

Summary

This bill mandates policing agencies in New York to inventory and publicly disclose their use of AI in criminal investigations.

Business Impact

If you operate a policing agency in New York, you must disclose your AI systems and their use by 2026 or face civil action.

Key Provisions

- Policing agencies must conduct an inventory of AI systems used in investigations.
- Agencies must publish disclosures about AI systems, with specific timelines to be confirmed by the bill text.

Compliance Checklist

- Publish a disclosure of AI systems used | Who: Policing agencies | Penalty: Civil action may be initiated by the attorney general or individuals.
- Adopt the model policy for AI use | Who: Policing agencies | Penalty: Civil action may be initiated for non-compliance.
