- Clarification on license plate frame visibility regarding state name, registration decal, and alphanumeric designation.
- Implementation of a Next-generation Traffic Signal Modernization Grant Program.

- Apply for grant funding for traffic signal modernization using AI. | Who: Counties and municipalities operating traffic signals. | Penalty: Risk of outdated systems and loss of funding opportunities.
- Submit annual reports on support for the commercial space launch industry. | Who: Seaports located in designated spaceport territories. | Penalty: Potential loss of state funding and support.
