Urges generative artificial intelligence companies to make voluntary commitments regarding employee whistleblower protections.

Introduced

Risk: Low

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Jan 13, 2026): Introduced in the Senate, Referred to Senate Labor Committee

Summary

This non-binding bill urges generative AI companies to adopt voluntary commitments for employee whistleblower protections.

Business Impact

If you operate a generative AI company in New Jersey, you should implement whistleblower protections to foster a safe reporting environment.

Key Provisions

- Urges generative AI companies to adopt whistleblower protections voluntarily.
- Encourages voluntary commitments rather than imposing mandatory regulations.

Compliance Checklist

- Implement whistleblower protections for employees | Who: Generative AI companies | Penalty: None specified, as this is a voluntary commitment.
