## TRAIN Act Transparency and Responsibility for Artificial Intelligence Networks Act

### Summary

The TRAIN Act, a federal bill, is intended to assist copyright owners by proposing an administrative subpoena process to identify works used in AI model training. Analysis is based solely on the official description.

### Business Impact

If you use AI for model training, you must comply with copyright identification requests by January 1, 2025, or face legal penalties.

### Key Provisions

- Proposes an administrative subpoena process for copyright owners, though specifics are unconfirmed due to the absence of the bill text.
- Issuing authority and conditions for subpoenas are unconfirmed.
- Privacy compliance measures are unconfirmed.
