Summary

The Commonsense Reporting Act of 2017 modifies employer reporting requirements for health insurance coverage to the IRS.

Business Impact

If you develop or use AI technologies, you must prepare security strategies as directed by the NSA.

Key Provisions

- Directs the NSA to develop specific strategies for securing AI technologies, including risk assessment methodologies and threat detection protocols.
- Includes reporting requirements to Congress and establishes oversight mechanisms.
- Addresses national security concerns related to AI, demonstrating federal recognition of AI security needs.
