Summary

AB2544 proposes a pilot program for filmmaker education, but the absence of the full bill text means details on objectives, partnerships, duration, funding, and employment impact cannot be confirmed.

Business Impact

If you operate in education, you must review changes to pupil instruction requirements.

Key Provisions

- Establishment of a pilot program for filmmaker education (Article 9.1, Section 12100.95); details on objectives, partnerships, duration, funding, and employment impact are not available without the full bill text.

Compliance Checklist

- Establish partnerships with industry stakeholders for the pilot program | Who: GO-Biz | Penalty: Potential loss of funding or support for the program
- Develop and implement AI literacy curriculum | Who: Educational institutions and industry partners | Penalty: Inability to participate in the pilot program
