Business Impact

If you operate educational institutions in Florida, you must implement AI usage policies and training by July 1, 2026, or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- State Board of Education to propose AI standards and policies.
- State Board of Education to direct specified teacher training.
- Instruction on digital literacy and AI ethics proposed for specified grade levels.
- School districts to comply with AI policies and standards.
- The department to review school district compliance with AI policies.

Compliance Checklist

- Adopt AI usage policies and standards | Who: State Board of Education | Penalty: Non-compliance may lead to oversight reviews.
- Provide teacher training on AI | Who: Department of Education | Penalty: Potential compliance issues if not completed.
- Implement student instruction on digital literacy and AI ethics | Who: School districts | Penalty: Scrutiny from the State Board of Education.
