Central Valley School Safety Coordination Pilot Program.

Introduced

Study/Task Force

Last Action (Apr 09, 2026): Set for hearing April 14.

Summary

SB1181 establishes a pilot program to improve school safety communication, without explicitly targeting absenteeism and mental health.

Business Impact

If you operate in Central Valley schools, you must engage in safety coordination by 2029 or face non-compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Central Valley School Safety Coordination Pilot Program (Section 8590.31).
- Requires compliance with privacy laws and prohibits bulk monitoring (Section 8590.32).
- Mandates a report to the Legislature by January 1, 2029 (Section 8590.33).
- Repeals the provisions on January 1, 2030 (Section 8590.34).

Compliance Checklist

- Establish communication protocols with regional fusion centers | Who: Local educational agencies | Penalty: Potential funding losses if not compliant
- Implement training for school personnel on threat awareness | Who: Participating educational institutions | Penalty: Potential funding losses if not compliant
