## Relating To A Statewide Data And Artificial Intelligence Governance And Decision Intelligence Center.

### Summary

Establishes a statewide data and AI governance center to improve data quality and sharing across Hawaii, effective July 1, 2025.

### Business Impact

If you operate in Hawaii and handle data or AI, you must comply with new governance standards by July 1, 2025, or face potential penalties.

### Key Provisions

- Establishes a data and AI governance center under the chief data officer.
- Facilitates statewide data sharing and interoperability among agencies.
- Implements policies for responsible use of data and AI.
- Creates a statewide integrated data and AI platform for analytics.
- Appropriates funds for necessary staff positions to support the center.
- Defines key terms related to data governance and decision intelligence.
