Summary

MD HB1057: Education - Artificial Intelligence - Guidelines, Professional Development, and Collaborative (Artificial Intelligence Ready Schools Act) requires the State Department of Education to develop and publish strategies and guidance for the use of AI in education through an online platform, providing guidance to parents, students, and educators.

Business Impact

If you operate a school in Maryland, you must designate an AI coordinator and follow state guidelines by the upcoming school year or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- State Department of Education to develop and publish strategies for implementing certain guidelines and best practices.
- State Department of Education to provide AI guidance through an online platform for local school systems, educators, parents, and students.
- Local school systems must designate an AI coordinator.
- Department to publish guidance for certain groups, including local school systems, educators, parents, and students, emphasizing a collaborative approach.
