## AGING-SCAM/ROBOCALLS INFO

## Summary

SB3719 requires the Illinois Department on Aging to update resources on scam calls, including AI scams, and provide access to a scam call hotline number.

## Business Impact

If you operate in Illinois and use AI for customer interactions, you must update your scam call resources by [date] or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Requires the Department on Aging to update resources on scam calls and robocalls (20 ILCS 105/8.14 new), but not limited to these.
- Resources must include information on AI-utilizing predatory scam calls.
- Resources must provide access to a scam call hotline number where call recipients may report predatory calls.
