## Ban on government social scoring with AI.

## Summary

HB0091 prohibits Wyoming government entities from using AI for social scoring and biometric identification, with exceptions for law enforcement and national security. Effective July 1, 2024.

## Business Impact

If you operate in Wyoming, you must cease any AI-driven social scoring or biometric identification practices by the bill's enactment date or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Prohibits government entities from using AI to calculate and assign social scores.
- Bans the use of AI for identifying individuals through biometric data or image gathering.
- Includes exceptions for law enforcement and national security purposes.
- Effective date is July 1, 2024.
- The bill provides definitions as stated in the official description.
- Penalties for violations include fines and potential suspension of government contracts.

- Stop using AI for biometric identification | Who: All government entities in Wyoming | Penalty: To be determined, as specific penalties are not outlined
