Providing for artificial intelligence in facilities, for artificial intelligence use by insurers and for artificial intelligence use by MA or CHIP managed care plans; imposing duties on the Department of Health, the Insurance Department and the Department of Human Services; and imposing penalties.

## Summary

HB1925 regulates AI in health facilities, insurance, and MA/CHIP plans, detailing department duties. Specific penalties and oversight require full bill text.

## Business Impact

If you use AI in health facilities or insurance, you must comply with new regulations or face unspecified penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Amends Titles 35, 40, and 67 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes regarding AI use in health facilities, by insurers, and in MA/CHIP managed care plans.
- Imposes duties on the Department of Health, the Insurance Department, and the Department of Human Services. Specific oversight responsibilities require access to the full bill text.
- The nature of penalties for non-compliance is not detailed in the available bill description.
