Summary

HI HB1782: Relating To Artificial Intelligence For The Protection Of Minors, effective 1/1/2077. Specific details on provisions will be included once the full bill text is available.

Business Impact

If you use AI to interact with minors, you must implement safeguards by January 1, 2077, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Specific details on safeguards, protections, oversight, and penalties will be included once the full bill text is available. The bill's effective date of 1/1/2077 is unusually far in the future, warranting further context.

Compliance Checklist

- Implement a minor protection plan and publish it on the provider's website. | Who: Providers of conversational AI services or AI companion systems. | Penalty: Civil penalties of up to \$15,000 per violation per day.
- Ensure clear disclosures about AI interactions are provided to minors. | Who: Providers of conversational AI services or AI companion systems. | Penalty: Civil penalties of up to \$15,000 per violation per day.
