Summary

HF4452 may require AI chatbots to disclose their non-human nature, but specific penalties and enforcement mechanisms cannot be confirmed without the full bill text.

Business Impact

If you use AI chatbots in Minnesota, you must comply with new technology requirements or face legal action for any resulting harm.

Key Provisions

- AI chatbots may need to disclose their non-human nature.
- Speculates a cause of action for harm caused by AI chatbots.
- Specific consequences for non-compliance are not confirmed.
