Prohibits the development of artificial intelligence systems with certain capabilities involving interactions with minors (OR SEE FISC NOTE GF EX)

Summary

HB295 prohibits certain AI systems involving minors in Louisiana. The analysis is speculative without the full bill text and fiscal note details.

Business Impact

If you develop AI systems that interact with minors in Louisiana, you must cease development immediately to avoid legal repercussions.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits the development of AI systems with certain capabilities involving interactions with minors in Louisiana. Full bill text is needed to clarify specific capabilities, exceptions, enforcement mechanisms, and fiscal implications. The fiscal note (GF EX) may provide additional insights.
