Risk: Low

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (May 03, 2013): Died in Health Policy

Summary

The bill exempts children in certain licensed residential programs from mandatory Medicaid managed care enrollment.

Business Impact

If you handle AI-related investigations, note that this bill was not enacted.

Key Provisions

- Exemption from public records requirements for AI violation investigation information by the Department of Legal Affairs.
- Conditions for future legislative review and potential repeal of the exemption are specified in the bill, including a review period.
- The statement of public necessity is not assumed without the full bill text.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure all AI violation investigation information is kept confidential until the investigation is complete. | Who: Operators of AI systems and the Department of Legal Affairs. | Penalty: Potential legal consequences for unauthorized disclosure.
- Review and update data handling practices to comply with confidentiality requirements. | Who: Businesses operating AI systems. | Penalty: Risk of legal challenges and loss of proprietary information.
