Requires healthcare providers and healthcare facilities to inform patients of the use of artificial intelligence to memorialize patient visits.

This bill mandates healthcare providers to notify patients about the use of AI in memorializing visits, though the form of notification and scope are not specified in the available description.

Business Impact

Key Provisions

- Healthcare providers must inform patients of AI use in visit documentation, though the form is not specified in the available description.
- The applicability to healthcare facilities in Rhode Island is not specified in the available description and should be verified with the full bill text.
