Last Action (Nov 25, 2025): Referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, and in addition to the Committee on Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

Summary

The federal AI for America Act establishes a national AI strategy to promote U.S. leadership, remove regulatory barriers, and ensure data are free from security risks and ideological bias.

Business Impact

If you develop or use AI technologies, you must align with new national strategies and compliance measures by implementation dates to avoid penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a national strategy for artificial intelligence.
- Promotes American leadership in AI technologies.
- Aims to remove regulatory barriers to AI development.
- Focuses on ensuring data are free from security risks and ideological bias.
- Includes 'other purposes' as stated in the official description.
