County Boards of Education - Artificial Intelligence Training Program - Requirement

Summary

The bill mandates annual AI training for county board members, covering technology developments and best practices in education.

Business Impact

If you operate a county board of education, you must complete annual AI training by July 1 or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- State Department of Education must develop or approve an AI training program.
- Training includes foundational and continuing annual education.
- Each county board member must complete the training annually.
- Training can be delivered in person, online, or in a hybrid format.
