Summary

SB3027 prohibits hospitals in Illinois from using artificial intelligence, as defined by the Illinois Human Rights Act, to set or influence health care pricing or billing.

Business Impact

If you operate a hospital in Illinois, you must stop using AI for health care pricing or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits hospitals from using artificial intelligence in health care pricing.
- Defines 'artificial intelligence' as per the Illinois Human Rights Act.
- Amends the Fair Patient Billing Act to include new provisions.
