Summary

This bill extends provisions for the 2026-2027 budget, including recruitment incentives, procurement provisions, and PILOT payments for state-owned lands in Ulster county. Subpart A in Part C is intentionally omitted.

Business Impact

If you operate in New York and use 3D printing technology, you must comply with new firearm prevention regulations by 2026 or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Extends the recruitment incentive and retention program for certain active members of the New York army national guard, New York air national guard, and New York naval militia.
- Extends the suspension of the subsidy from the public safety communications surcharge to the state emergency services revolving loan fund until 2028.
- Increases frequency of education and training in ethics and lobbying, with fees for non-compliance.
- Requires the superintendent of state police to develop a critical incident paid leave policy.
- Establishes a firearm prevention working group to submit a report on the technological feasibility of blocking technology in 3D printers to prevent the printing of firearms or firearm parts.
- Establishes a three-dimensional printed firearm library.
- Extends provisions related to temporary retail permits and extends lobbyist registration fees through March 31, 2026.
- Mandates PILOT payments for state-owned lands in Ulster county.
