Artificial Intelligence; state agencies required to perform quarterly AI-assisted review of rules

Summary

SB328 requires Alabama state agencies to conduct quarterly AI-assisted reviews of their rules, based on the official description. The full bill text is not available, so specific mechanisms and potential exceptions cannot be confirmed.

Business Impact

If you operate a state agency in Alabama, you must conduct quarterly AI-assisted reviews of your rules by the specified deadlines or face regulatory penalties.

Key Provisions

- State agencies must conduct quarterly reviews of rules using AI assistance, based on the official description, but specific mechanisms and potential exceptions cannot be confirmed as the bill text is not available.
