SCH CD-AI USE IN EDUC COMM

Summary

The bill establishes an Artificial-Intelligence Use in Education Commission to recommend best practices for AI and smartphone use in schools, effective January 1, 2027, with provisions repealed on January 1, 2030.

Business Impact

If you operate educational institutions in Illinois, you must comply with AI use recommendations by January 1, 2027, or risk non-compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- Establishes an Artificial-Intelligence Use in Education Commission.
- Commission to recommend best practices for AI and smartphone use in schools.
- Specifies the Commission's responsibilities, membership, meetings, and support and reporting requirements.
- Effective January 1, 2027.
- Provisions repealed on January 1, 2030.
