AI-PRESCRIBING MEDICATION

Introduced

Risk: High

Amendment

Last Action (May 22, 2026): Rule 3-9(a) / Re-referred to Assignments

Summary

The bill prohibits licensed medical professionals from allowing AI to prescribe medication without full control and responsibility, with penalty provisions for violations. 'Artificial intelligence' is defined as per the Illinois Human Rights Act.

Business Impact

If you are a licensed medical professional in Illinois, you must ensure full control over any AI-assisted prescriptions or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Defines 'artificial intelligence' per the Illinois Human Rights Act.
- Prohibits licensed professionals from allowing AI to prescribe medication without full control.
- Establishes penalty provisions for violations.
- Grants the Department investigatory and rulemaking authority.
- Effective immediately upon becoming law.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure full control over any AI-assisted medication prescriptions. | Who: Licensed medical professionals in Illinois. | Penalty: Up to \$10,000 per violation.
- Stay informed about rules established by the Department regarding AI use. | Who: Licensed medical professionals and healthcare entities. | Penalty: Potential civil penalties for non-compliance.
