Relating to the temporary use of average enrollment for purposes of the public school finance system for a school district located in a disaster area.

This bill allows the temporary use of average enrollment figures for school finance in disaster-affected districts.

Business Impact

If you use algorithms to set rental prices in Texas, you must ensure compliance with this bill or face potential penalties.

- Pending verification of specific guidelines and provisions.
- Potential impacts on landlords and property management companies require confirmation.
