To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to limit the penalty for late enrollment under part B of the Medicare Program to 15 percent and twice the period of no enrollment, and to exclude periods of COBRA, retiree, and VA coverage from such late enrollment penalty.

Summary

The Fair Grocery Pricing Act prohibits food producers from using algorithmic systems to manipulate food prices or supply.

Business Impact

If you produce food and use algorithms for pricing, you must ensure compliance with this act to avoid penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits food producers from using algorithmic systems to inflate prices.
- Prohibits food producers from using algorithmic systems to reduce supply.
- Targets practices that exploit market dynamics through automated decision-making.

Compliance Checklist

- Ensure pricing algorithms do not inflate prices or reduce supply. | Who: Food producers | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified.
