Prohibits public contracts with entities owned or controlled by foreign adversaries for the provision of artificial intelligence technology (OR NO IMPACT See Note)

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Apr 01, 2026): Read by title, under the rules, referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

Summary

This bill prohibits public contracts with entities owned or controlled by foreign adversaries for AI technology provision, with specific criteria and exceptions outlined.

Business Impact

If you provide AI technology to public entities in Louisiana, you must ensure your ownership is not foreign-controlled or face contract disqualification.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits public contracts with entities owned by foreign adversaries for AI technology, with defined criteria and exceptions.

Compliance Checklist

- Evaluate ownership structure to ensure compliance with the prohibition. | Who: Businesses providing AI technology to public entities. | Penalty: Potential disqualification from public contracts.
