Trade: business regulation; requirements and safety standards for developers of certain artificial intelligence models; provide for. Creates new act.

## Summary

The bill mandates developers of AI models to implement safety protocols and report on critical risks.

## Business Impact

If you develop AI models in Michigan, you must implement safety protocols and publish reports by January 1, 2026, or face fines up to \$1 million.

## Key Provisions

- Developers must implement and publish safety and security protocols.
- Developers must produce transparency reports detailing risk assessments.
- Civil fines for non-compliance are not confirmed without the full bill text.
- The duration for record retention is not confirmed without the full bill text.
- Protection from retaliation for employees reporting critical risks is not confirmed without the full bill text.
- Developers must adhere to the specified timeline for publishing modifications to safety protocols is not confirmed without the full bill text.

## Compliance Checklist

- Implement and publish a safety and security protocol | Who: Large developers of AI models | Penalty: Up to \$1 million per violation
- Produce and publish transparency reports every 90 days | Who: Large developers of AI models | Penalty: Up to \$1 million per violation
