Last Action (Apr 13, 2026): Re-referred to Com. on P. & C.P.

Summary

AB2575 addresses the use of AI in health care, but specific mandates and protections require verification with the full bill text.

Business Impact

If you operate a health facility using AI tools, you must disclose detailed information about these tools by February 1, 2028, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- The requirement for health facilities to disclose AI tools needs verification.
- Worker protections for overriding AI outputs require confirmation.
- Prohibition of AI replacing professional judgment needs checking.
- Definitions of AI and clinical decision support systems need verification.
- Reimbursement requirements for local agencies require confirmation.
- Liability issues related to AI outputs need verification.

Compliance Checklist

- Provide written notice of AI tool details to health care professionals | Who: Health facilities, clinics, and physician offices | Penalty: Subject to enforcement actions and penalties for non-compliance
- Ensure workers are aware they can override AI outputs | Who: Employers in health care | Penalty: Retaliation against workers is prohibited and subject to complaints
