Introduced

Risk: Medium

Comprehensive

Last Action (May 18, 2026): Read second time. Ordered to third reading.

Summary

AB2575 proposes adding sections to California's Civil, Health and Safety, and Labor Codes concerning AI in health care, but specifics require full bill text.

Business Impact

If you use AI in health care, review new legal obligations under AB2575.

Key Provisions

- Addition of Section 1714.48 to the Civil Code
- Addition of Section 1339.76 to the Health and Safety Code
- Addition of Article 2.7 (commencing with Section 2820) to Chapter 2 of Division 3 of the Labor Code

Compliance Checklist

- Provide written notice of AI tool details to health care professionals | Who: Health facilities, clinics, and physician offices | Penalty: Subject to enforcement actions and penalties for non-compliance
- Ensure workers are aware they can override AI outputs | Who: Employers in health care | Penalty: Retaliation against workers is prohibited and subject to complaints
