Summary

HF4532 proposes AI safety and disclosure requirements, pending verification of specific provisions from the bill text.

Business Impact

If you operate in Minnesota and use AI, you must comply with safety and disclosure requirements by the effective date or face civil penalties.

Key Provisions

- Proposes AI safety standards.
- Suggests disclosure of AI operations.
- Civil remedies for non-compliance need verification.

- Disclose risks and safety measures of AI systems | Who: AI developers and deployers | Penalty: Civil remedies for individuals harmed
- Ensure AI systems meet established safety requirements | Who: All entities developing AI systems | Penalty: Fines and civil liabilities
