Senate Bill 1694 provides requirements for technology components in general education and AI instruction in high school computer science courses in Florida.

Business Impact

If you operate a high school, ensure AI is taught in computer science courses by July 1, 2026.

- Requires a technology component in general education core courses.
- Requires AI instruction in high school computer science courses.

- Review and update general education core courses | Who: Faculty committees appointed by the State Board of Education | Penalty: Non-compliance could affect course approval
