AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 29; Title 37 and Title 47, relative to artificial intelligence.

The CHAT Act proposes amendments to Tennessee laws to regulate AI. Specific details will be included once the full bill text is available.

Business Impact

If you develop or use AI technologies in Tennessee, you must comply with new regulations by the effective date or face penalties.

- Specific provisions will be included upon verification of amendments to Titles 29, 37, and 47 regarding AI regulation.
