## Workforce of the Future Act of 2025

Introduced

Last Action (Dec 11, 2025): Referred to the Committee on Education and Workforce, and in addition to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

## Summary

US HB6621: Workforce of the Future Act of 2025 focuses on promoting a 21st-century workforce, including training and quality employment in industries most impacted by AI.

## Business Impact

If you operate in emerging technologies, you must implement workforce training programs by January 2026 or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Authorizes grants for education in emerging and advanced technologies.
- Emphasizes quality employment in industries most impacted by AI.

## Compliance Checklist

- Apply for grants to support technology education programs | Who: Educational institutions and training providers | Penalty: Loss of funding eligibility for non-compliance
- Develop training programs aligned with AI industry needs | Who: Training providers and educational institutions | Penalty: Ineligibility for future grants if programs are not developed
