Artificial Intelligence in Education Task Force Act; enact.

Summary

The bill creates an AI in Education Task Force to explore AI in K-12, with specific membership criteria and duties, submitting biannual reports until July 1, 2025.

Business Impact

If you operate in the education sector in Mississippi, you must prepare for AI integration recommendations by December 15, 2026.

Key Provisions

- Establishes an AI in Education Task Force to evaluate AI applications in K-12 education.
- Task force to include members appointed based on expertise in education and technology, with criteria such as experience in AI implementation and policy development.
- Requires the task force to submit biannual reports to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and Speaker of the House.
- Task force to develop policy recommendations for responsible AI use in education, evaluate AI's impact on student learning and teacher training, and strategies for fostering collaboration.
- The task force shall dissolve on July 1, 2025.
