## Summary

Senate Bill 640 addresses AI ethics and literacy in North Carolina's education system without specific mandates.

## Business Impact

If you operate educational institutions in North Carolina, you must integrate AI ethics into your curriculum by the next academic year or face compliance issues.

## Key Provisions

- Addresses AI ethics in education without specific mandates.
- Does not specify application to any education level.
- Highlights the importance of understanding AI technologies.
- Does not require development of teaching materials.
- Does not mention collaboration between educators and technology experts.
- Does not explicitly aim to prepare students for ethical challenges in a tech-driven world.
